Notice of Survey Work at Ingestre

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are writing to make you aware of the next stage of HS2-related work that the British Pipeline Agency (BPA) will undertake.

What we are doing

Due to the future planned HS2 railway development works, BPA need to divert an existing pipeline that will cross the new railway line. From February to September 2022 they will be carrying out initial site surveys and assessments, including ecological, archaeological and ground investigations. Most of these assessments will be carried out between February and April, with follow-up work to be completed afterwards.

Covid-19

We are working in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. For all events and engagement, we will carry out a risk assessment and put in place control measures to manage the risk of Covid-19 to the public and our staff. How will this affect me?

Works will take place near to Ingestre, within rural fields. For all activity, we will be working Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm. As the works are largely within rural fields there should be limited disruption to local businesses, although there will be a slight increase in construction traffic.

Take and test soil samples.

Complete ecological walkover surveys.

Carry out ground investigation works.

Search for buried services.
